

Around Laos

While the most popular destinations in Laos are Luang Prabang and Vientiane, there is much more to see and experience in this lovely country, known as the 'Jewel of the Mekong'.

Vang Vieng provides a great stopover between the two major destinations and offers a wealth of activities surrounding its dramatic karst limestone scenery.

Further to the north is Luang Namtha, which has the highest variety of ethnic groups of any one province in Laos (over 32 different ethnic groups). Xieng Khouang is the site of the enigmatic Plain of Jars.



Heading southwards, Khammouane and Savannakhet offer a great gateway into rural Laos, while if you continue further south you will come to Champasak Province – containing the UNESCO World Heritage site of Wat Phou, the Bolaven Plateau and the spectacular Four Thousand Islands, with Southeast Asia's largest volume waterfall.
