Who are we and what do we do?

Rehab Craft Cambodia is a not-for-profit, non-religious, non-governmental organisation based in Phnom Penh that provides long-term and sustainable employment opportunities for Cambodians with physical disabilities, through the production and marketing of quality handi-crafts. Their physical disabilities range from landmine accidents to polio and birth defects, which inhibits them from finding meaningful employment. We address both the needs and negative perceptions of persons with disabilities, by helping them to take responsibility for their future. The organisation is run by and for Cambodians with disabilities - a powerful example to those who still believe that disability equals dependence.

Established in 1995, Rehab Craft Cambodia employs over 15 producers and more than 10 people in support, administration and management roles. We provide training, workspace and support to self-employed wood carvers and jewellery makers. Profits from the sale of products are reinvested into our training and employment programmes. We pay above average wages and we maintain staff benefit and loan programmes to support individual, family or emergency needs. All expenses related to disability (such as prosthetics or wheelchairs) are fully paid for by Rehab Craft Cambodia.

We recently opened a new workshop and training centre for 10 trainee-producers above our store in Siem Reap. All trainees were previously unskilled and unemployed, but after a comprehensive 6-month training programme, their products which include bags, purses, wallets, photo-frames, wall-hangings etc. are sold in our store.

What you can experience

- Buy some gifts in our store in Siem Reap (near the old market) which sells products made by our employees as well as independent disabled producers.
- Custom-made products can also be ordered on-line and shipped overseas.
- Tours of our workshop and training centre can be organised through your hotel or guesthouse. These provide opportunities to see trainee-producers at work, find out more about our organisation and talk to trainees about their lives and experiences with help from our staff interpreters.
