Who are we and what do we do?

Angkor Hospital for Children is dedicated to improving the health and future of Cambodia's children by providing full service, life saving paediatric care to over 100,000 sick and injured children per year. Services include outpatient and inpatient care, basic surgery, a 24-hour emergency service, and a dental clinic. The dedicated staff of doctors and nurses provide services free-of-charge for between 300 to 500 babies and children per day. The hospital was founded in 1999 by the internationally-acclaimed Japanese photographer Kenro Izu. He created the organisation *Friends Without A Border (Friends)*, to fund and support Angkor Hospital for Children.

Hospital services are critically needed in Cambodia because persecution of educated professionals during the Khmer Rouge regime reduced the country's doctors to only 50. Designated by the Ministry of Health as one of two teaching hospitals in the country, Angkor Hospital for Children is preparing the next generation of Cambodian doctors, nurses and hospital administrators by training over 1,000 health care professionals a year.

What you can experience

Blood banks are in scarce supply in Cambodia, so we encourage all visitors to Siem Reap who are interested in donating blood to enquire at the hospital.
