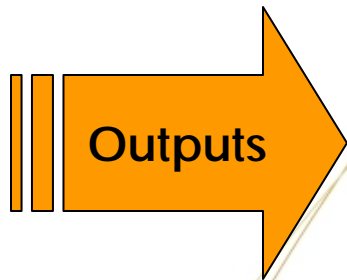

90 projects implemented in 39 countries and 4 regions (23 frontier, 16 non-frontier countries)
Total Funding: \$35,506,138; Total Spent: \$9,965,511 (28% of total funding)



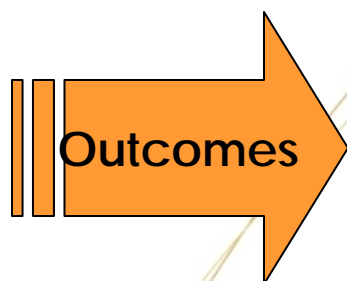
- 478 reports/notes/surveys produced in 25 countries and regions¹
- 196 training/conferences/meetings/focus groups conducted in 19 countries and regions²
- 869 people trained or participated in focus groups in Bangladesh, Belarus, Bhutan, China, Madagascar, Philippines, Russia, Rwanda, Sierra Leone, South Africa and World region
- 79 dialogues between public and private sector took place in 10 projects in Russia, Sudan, Tajikistan and Tonga
- 51 laws/regulations and reform programs to which improvements have been recommended/proposed in Albania, Belarus, Bhutan, Bulgaria, Burkina Faso, Indonesia, Russian, Solomon Islands, Sudan and Tajikistan
- 43 recommendations provided to Government and clients in Belarus, Bhutan, Bulgaria, Morocco, Russia, Sudan and Tajikistan

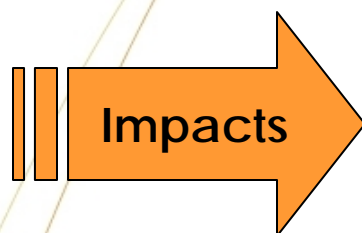

BEE Diagnostic and M&E: Results (cont.)

- 27 action plans and recommendations implemented by clients in Albania, Burkina Faso, China, Niger, Russia and Solomon Islands
- 48 procedures eliminated/streamlined in 6 projects implemented Fiji, Kenya, Niger, Russia and World region
- 7 laws/regulations changed/passed in Sierra Leone, Sudan and Tajikistan

BEE Policy, Regulation and Institutions: Results

Jan 04 - Jun 07

77 projects implemented in 40 countries and 8 regions (22 frontier, 18 non-frontier countries)

Total Funding: \$40,172,652; Total Spent: \$ \$16,775,600 (42% of total funding)



Outputs

- 113 reports/policy study/notes/surveys produced by 38 projects in 17 countries¹
- 259 administrative procedures proposed for improvement or cancellation by 10 projects in Bangladesh, Georgia, Jordan, Mexico, Namibia, Tajikistan, Ukraine, and Uzbekistan
- 208 laws/regulations to which improvements have been recommended/analyzed in Belarus, Egypt, Georgia, Mexico, Namibia, Nepal, Russian, Tajikistan, Ukraine, and Uzbekistan
- 32 laws/regulations drafted or contributed to drafting in Egypt, Indonesia, Lebanon, Lesotho, Nepal, Peru, Poland, Tajikistan, Uganda and Ukraine
- 397 training/seminar/public events/workshops held in 17 countries² and Caribbean region
- More than 6,000 people trained/consulted, including 2,500 government officials in 13 countries³ and South Africa region

BEE Policy, Regulation and Institutions: Results Jan 04- Jun 07 (cont'd)

- 54 laws/regulations passed/enacted in Bangladesh, Belarus, Egypt, Indonesia, Lao, Tajikistan, Ukraine, Uzbekistan and Vietnam (MPDF)
- 183 recommendations adopted/implemented in Belarus Egypt, Georgia, Indonesia, Lebanon, Senegal, Tajikistan, Ukraine, Uzbekistan (90) and Vietnam
- Over 150 administrative procedures improved/eliminated/streamlined in Bangladesh, Belarus, Egypt, Lebanon, Tajikistan (68) Ukraine and Uzbekistan

Total Funding: \$15,336,561; Total Spent: \$5,038,624 (33% of total funding)



Outputs

- 83 reports/studies/assessments produced in 17 projects
- 128 seminars/training/workshops held in Bolivia, Brazil, Cambodia, Colombia, Indonesia, Nicaragua, Nigeria, Peru, Vietnam, Africa and LCA regions
- 243 municipality officers and clients trained in Bolivia, Colombia, Honduras, Peru and Vietnam



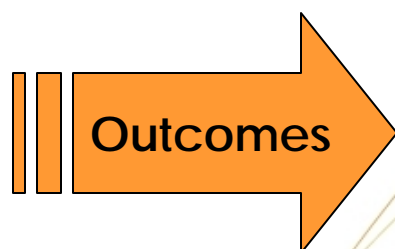
Outcomes

- 18 new policies/legislation/procedures adopted/changed in Indonesia, Mexico and Vietnam

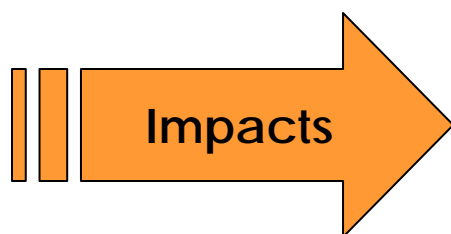

Industry-specific BEE: Results (Aug 04-Jun 07)

**34 projects implemented in 19 countries and 4 regions¹ (13 frontier, 6 non-frontier countries)
Total Funding: \$15,873,267; Total Spent: \$2,588,722 (16% of total funding)**

Outputs

- 27 seminars/workshops held in Cambodia, China, Lao, Mozambique, Philippines and Vietnam
- Over 10,000 people trained in Algeria, China, Indonesia, Iraq, Timor-Leste, Pakistan and MENA region
- Over 600 unique organizations/government agencies assisted in Algeria, Cambodia, China, Lao, Peru and Vietnam
- 89 reports/study/survey/business plans/assessments produced in 12 countries and 2 regions

Outcomes

- 8,512 bookings realized through TOU- World Hotel Link (Vietnam) and World Hotel-link.com
- \$243,290 booking realized in Indonesia via Eco-Tourism
- 158 participating SMEs increased access to credit in Indonesia (Seaweed Industry Linkages Program)

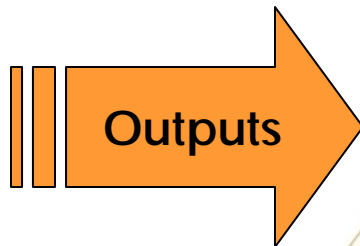

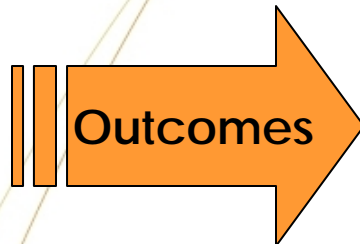

Business Advocacy: Results (Oct 03–Jun 07)

13 projects implemented in 9 countries and World region¹ (9 frontier countries)
Total Funding: \$5,359,302 Total Spent: \$2,507,868 (47% total funding)



- Over 400 meetings/public events/focus groups held in Cambodia, Cameroon, Lao, Pakistan, Sierra Leone and Vietnam
- 23 training events provided in Algeria, Indonesia and Morocco (World region project) and Pakistan
- 88 reports/papers/studies produced in Cambodia, Egypt, Lao, Pakistan, and Vietnam
- 4 new laws/regulations drafted in Sierra Leone



- 2 new or amended laws/regulations or policies enacted in Sierra Leone
- 124 issues addressed by the Governments of Vietnam and Lao
- \$7,500 spent by client in advocacy program in Pakistan

Dispute Resolution: Results (Jul 05-Jun 07)

**7 projects implemented in 7 countries¹ (5 frontier, 2 non-frontier countries)
Total Funding: \$4,817,448 Total Spent: \$2,694,654 (56% total funding)**

Outputs

- 163 training/workshops/roundtables/seminars held with 5,336 participants/judges/lawyers/mediators
- Over 1,600 hours of advisory service provided to various clients in Bosnia and Herzegovina and Serbia
- 9 new laws/regulations drafted/advised on in Bosnia and Herzegovina, Macedonia, Pakistan and Serbia

Outcomes

- 11 mediation centers/institutions in operation in Bosnia and Herzegovina and in Serbia
- Over 300 mediators practicing mediation independently in Bosnia and Herzegovina, Macedonia, Pakistan and Serbia
- Nearly 3,000 mediations completed in Bosnia and Herzegovina and in Serbia
- 6 laws/regulations passed in Bosnia and Herzegovina and Serbia

Impacts
