Outputs

- **87 training programs/modules/manuals** designed in 6 projects in Cambodia, China, Indonesia, Iraq, Tunisia and Vietnam
- **Over 108,68 people** attended training/workshops in 35 projects implemented in 21 countries and regions²
- **9,217 hours of advisory services** provided to various clients in 12 projects in Afghanistan, China, Indonesia, India, South Africa and Vietnam
- **85 unique entities/financial intermediaries** received advisory services through 15 projects in 14 countries and regions³
- **166 reports/studies/surveys and recommendations reports** produced by 37 projects in 24 countries and regions⁴
- **65 strategic/implementation plans**, scorecards, IT systems, tools and procedures reviewed/ developed/updated by 15 projects in 12 countries and regions⁵
- **17 laws/regulations** drafted or contributed to the drafting by 6 projects in Afghanistan, China, Lao and Pakistan

- **34 new products and delivery/distribution channels** developed/created in 9 projects in Bangladesh, Egypt, Iraq, Maldives, Saudi Arabia, Sri Lanka, Tajikistan and Tunisia
- **54 administrative procedures, new systems changed/in place/used** in 13 projects in Bangladesh, Bhutan, China, Egypt, Georgia, Oman, Philippines (EAP project), Saudi Arabia and Vietnam
- **24 new financial products developed/introduced** through 4 projects in Bangladesh, Egypt, Philippines and Saudi Arabia
- **199,182 bank clients gained** through 7 projects in Bangladesh, Burkina Faso, Egypt, Indonesia, Saudi Arabia and Tunisia
