# Projects Cumulative Aggregate Results<sup>4</sup>

### Outputs

- Assisted (trained/advised) 8360 firms in 10 countries
- 637 training events delivered to at least 6714 individuals in 14 countries and across EAP, CEU, MENA, SA and SECA
- Contributed to the drafting/amendment of 76 CG legislative acts/regulations in 9 countries
- 791<sup>4</sup> corporate docs developed/advised on in 8 countries and across 4 regions (CAF, CEU, LAC, MENA)
- 110 public information/awareness raising/media events held in 5 countries and across MENA, CAF and world regions

# 3. CG Projects Cumulative Aggregate Results<sup>4</sup>

## (April 1, 02 – June 30, 07)



### Outcomes

- 37 legislative acts passed/adopted
- 245 corporate documents adopted
- 435 companies in 7 countries improved CG practices/operations
- 45 educational institutions introduced/taught improved CG courses in Albania, Azerbaijan, China and Ukraine reaching at least 23164 students



### Impacts

- 2 billion US\$ Investment/financing enabled in Azerbaijan, Russia & Ukraine as a result of improved CG
