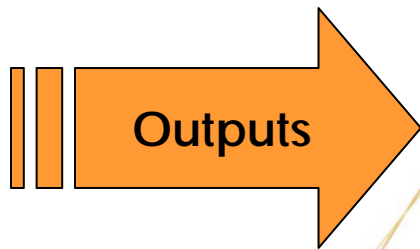

ESS Results at a Glance

Time Frame: Jul. 2002 – June 2007



- **190 reports/studies completed** by 48 projects in 26 countries, and regions
- **76 steering committee/ dialogues/ stakeholder meetings conducted** in Congo, Kyrgyz Republic, Russia, Sierra Leone, Central Asia and World regions
- **110 unique firms or organizations received IFC assistance** in China, Indonesia, Russia, South Africa, Central Europe and World regions
- **400 training events/workshops delivered**
- **38 training modules/materials developed** in Colombia, Ghana, Indonesia, Central Asia and World regions
- **8,476 people trained** in 16 countries and 3 regional projects²

Outcomes

- **29 SMEs adopting environmental principles and improving their practice** as results of AS projects implemented in Guatemala and World region
- **60 small loans were disbursed** through the World region projects (EBFP Conservation International & GEF EB - Environmental Business Finance Programs) and China



Impact

- **\$113,150,034 investment/financing enabled** by 6 projects in Congo, Central Europe and World Regions
- **47,067 protected areas of land in production areas** for Biodiversity projects in Poland, Peru, East Asia and Pacific and Latin America regions
- **1,100,926 CO2 emission reductions (CO2 equivalent tons/yr)** in Bangladesh, South Africa, Central Europe and World regions
- **76,000 people with access to clean water** in Sri-Lanka
- **1,448,316 earthquake victims receiving relief** in Pakistan
