Infrastructure Projects & Funding Statistics

- **54 projects¹ in 8 regions, 30 countries**
 - **8 Regions:** AF (15), EAP (8), CEU (1), LAC (11), SA (3), SECA (5), MENA (9), World (2)
 - **10 Departments:** CAS (29), CEA (2), CGB (1), CIN (9), CIT (4), CLA (1), CME (2), COC (2), CSE (3), CSF (1)

Infrastructure : To date Cumulative Results (Nov 01- June 07)

Active in 34 countries²

Outputs

- 9 bids conducted in 6 countries
- 103 strategic options reports completed/ reports (diagnostic studies, assessment, feasibility studies) in 29 countries
- 5429 businesses (Village phone operators) established in Uganda

Outcomes

- 7 agreements signed in 4 countries
- 100% of conducted bids successful (9 bids in 6 countries)
- 4 regulatory structures implemented in 3 countries
- 26 strategic options reports accepted by clients
- 100% Village phone operator businesses established received financing

Impacts

- US\$ 620.7M Investment/financing enabled in 4 countries³
- US\$ 959M in government receipts in 3 projects (Kenya-Uganda Railways Joint Concession, Saudi Arabia Hajj Terminal and Jordan Airport)
- 419,300 people receiving basic services (medical, IT, etc)
