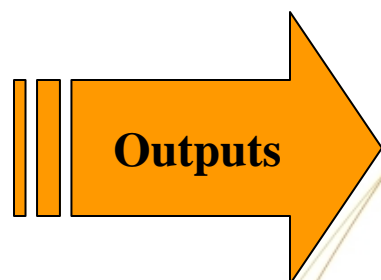

Active in 26 countries



- **162 MFIs assisted in Cambodia, China, Indonesia and across world region**
- **425 individuals trained in 13 countries**
- **60 MFI institutions/depts created and/or branch operations expanded in 10 countries**
- **Contributed to drafting/admending 10 new laws/regulations in Cambodia and Liberia**
- **51 reports produced in 21 countries**

IFC Microfinance Advisory Services (Feb. 27, 03- June 30, 07)

- 4 laws/regulations adopted in Cambodia
- 58898 active women borrowers and 87997 active women depositors in MENA region (Afghanistan, Morocco, West Bank & Gaza)
- 84252 loans worth US\$ 106.7M disbursed in Afghanistan, Congo DRC, MENA region, Tajikistan, West Bank & Gaza
- US\$ 97.6M worth of outstanding loans in 10 countries (over 74559 loans)
- 53495 new deposit accounts valued US\$ 963.4M opened in 8 countries
- Savings portfolio of US\$ 2.3M in West Bank & Gaza
