# SNAPSHOT OF HIGH-LEVEL FEEDBACK FROM CIVIL SOCIETY



## Climate

- Standalone Climate standard; focus on climate risk assessments and Paris Alignment
- Embed climate accounting and disclosure covenants into financial agreements
- Mandate best available techniques and public disclosure of mitigation analyses
- Improve and standardize emissions accounting and disclosure to require GHG reporting across Scope 1–3 emissions, including FI lending and sub-projects
- Independent oversight and transparency of climate-related reporting

# SNAPSHOT OF HIGH-LEVEL FEEDBACK FROM CIVIL SOCIETY



## Biodiversity and Animal Welfare

- Alignment with the Global Biodiversity Framework
- Stronger protection of critical habitats and stricter approach to no-go areas
- Reconsideration of the role and effectiveness of offsets
- Recognition of culturally significant ecosystems, including IPs zones
- Enhanced cumulative impact assessments and third-party verification
- Enhanced due diligence across supply chains
- Explicit animal welfare provisions

# SNAPSHOT OF HIGH-LEVEL FEEDBACK FROM CIVIL SOCIETY



## Extractives Industries

- Stronger provisions on contract disclosure for projects in extractives industries
- Stronger alignment with international standards like EITI and GRI
- Enhanced requirements of public country-by-country reporting at project level
- Beneficial Ownership considerations

# SNAPSHOT OF HIGH-LEVEL FEEDBACK FROM CIVIL SOCIETY



## Disability Inclusion

- Explicit recognition of disability inclusion in the Sustainability Framework policies and standards
- Mainstreaming disability and inclusion considerations across standards/policies
- Special focus in areas that address access to information
- Enhanced dialogues and consultations with disability-focused organizations

# SNAPSHOT OF HIGH-LEVEL FEEDBACK FROM CIVIL SOCIETY

## Indigenous Peoples (IPs)

- Explicit coverage of IPs in voluntary isolation, prohibiting contact and creating buffer zones
- Consideration of transboundary IPs whose territories are divided by country boundaries
- Expanded protection to IPs who have been displaced
- Stronger FPIC requirements
- Explicit integration of gender, age, and diversity considerations

# SNAPSHOT OF HIGH-LEVEL FEEDBACK FROM CIVIL SOCIETY



## Stakeholder Engagement

- Standalone Standard on Stakeholder Engagement
- Consideration of affected communities as rights holders
- Enhanced meaningful consultations throughout the entire business cycle, including stronger requirements for Broad Community Support (BCS) with more transparent implementation guidance
- Enhanced provisions to include and protect marginalized and vulnerable groups in the consultation processes
- Stronger project-level grievance mechanisms

# HIGH-LEVEL FEEDBACK ON THE ACCESS TO INFORMATION POLICY



## Transparency and disclosure: Access to Information Policy (AIP)

- Broader scope of information covered by AIP
- Revised approach to exceptions and refusals to align with best practices; evaluate declassification
- Proactive disclosure of project-level climate assessments, stakeholder engagement activities, sub-projects, private capital mobilization, trade finance activities
- Clearer/narrower definitions
- Up-to-date project disclosures: ensure policy provides for regular updates to proactive disclosures, i.e., project status, E&S action plans and documents, development results
- Implementation: Adopt best practice around information requests/appeals, enhanced website for greater navigation/accessibility, disclose implementation data

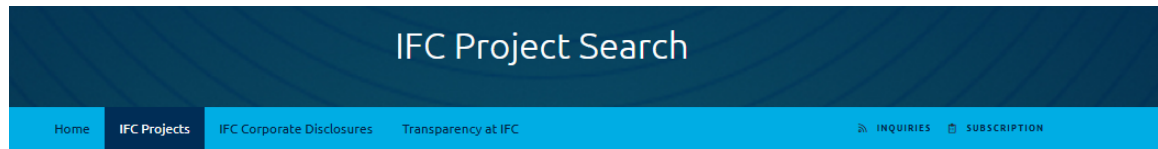
