EHome 5: The Bridgeview

Established by architect Nguyen Xuan Quang, Nam Long Investment Corporation has grown to become one of the leading real estate developers in Southern Vietnam. The company has responded to the demand for 70,000 low to middle income housing units in Ho Chi Minh City by building an average of 2,000-3,000 affordable and environmentally-friendly EHome residences per year.



Nam Long’s EHome 5, also called “The Bridgeview,” is an apartment complex comprised of 592 reasonably-priced one-bedroom units. The property is located within easy walking distance to schools, parks, and markets, just a few kilometers from the central downtown district. Amenities include a community club, riverside park, and nursery school.
